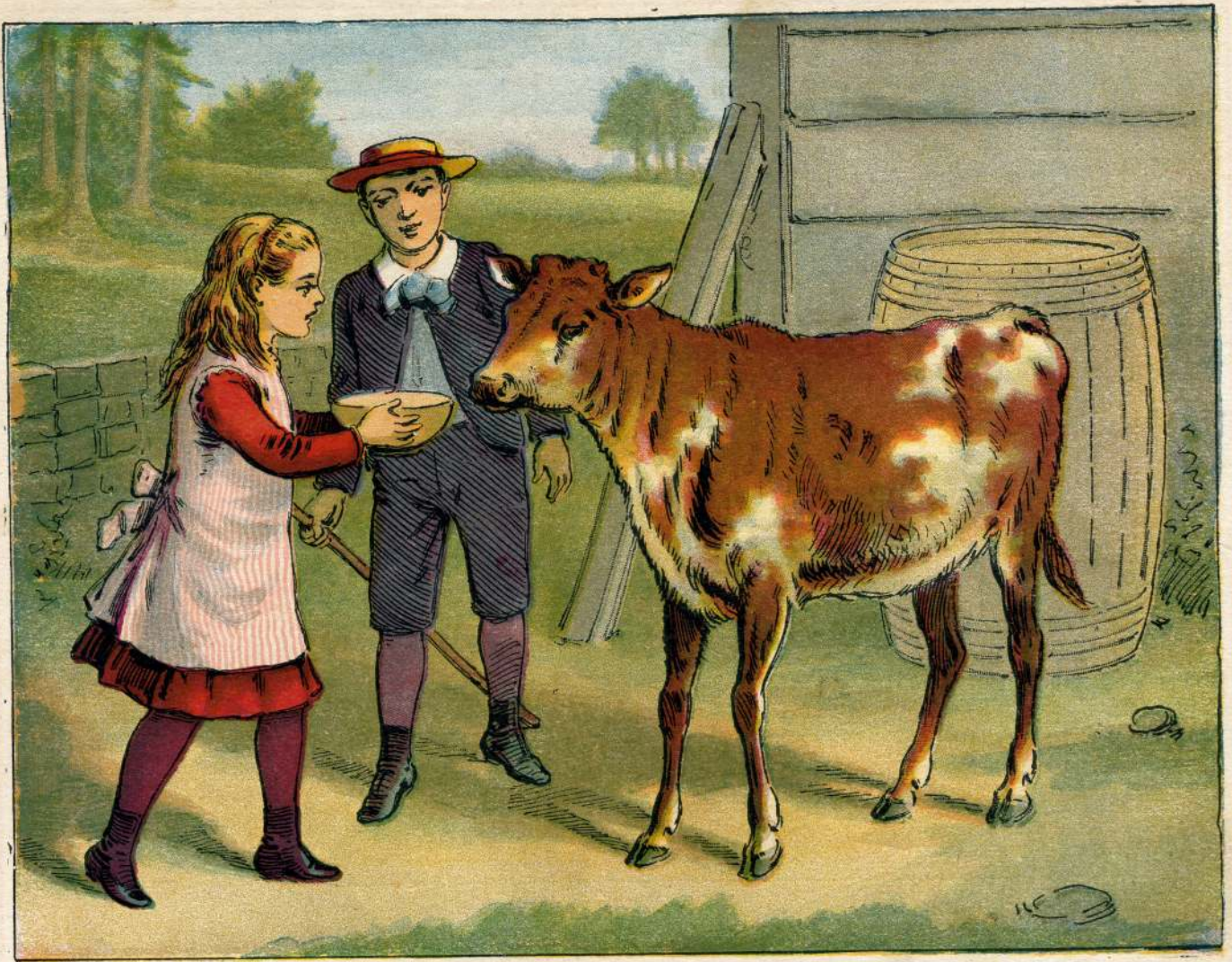


### THE DONKEY RIDE.
