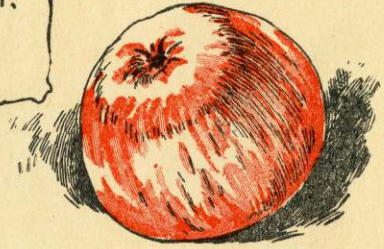

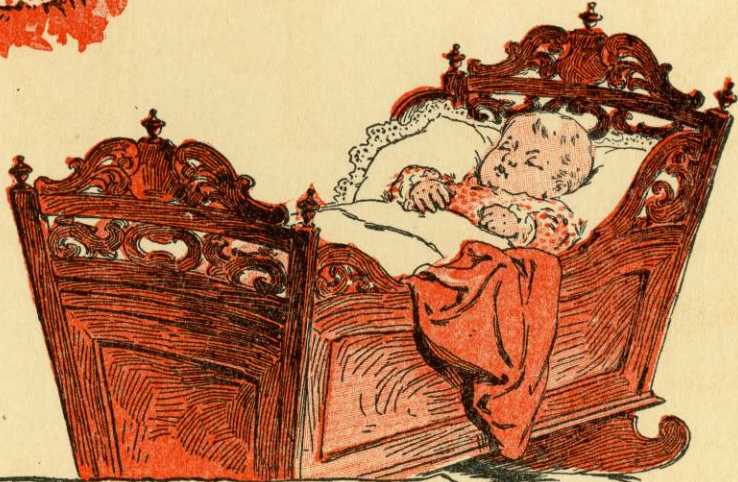
A

sinks sweetly to rest.

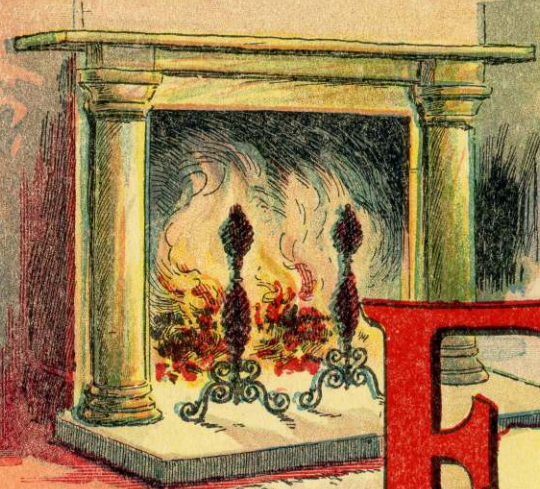




D is the Dolls,

as other Folks do.

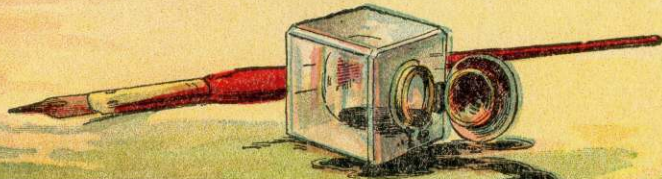


H

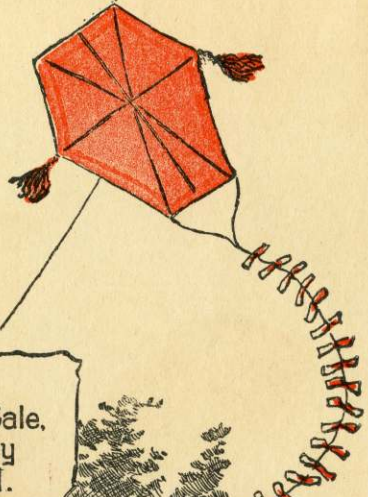
I is the Ink-stand

held fast to its tail.

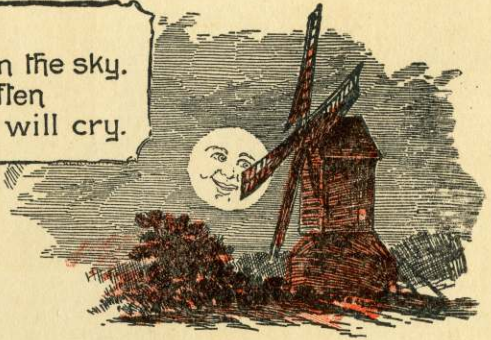


L

The Baby will cry.



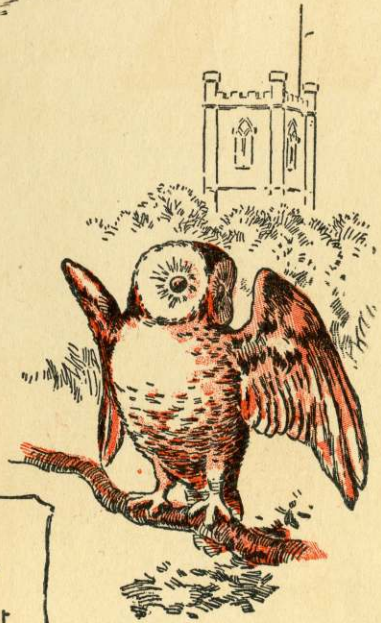
N

There at his ease.



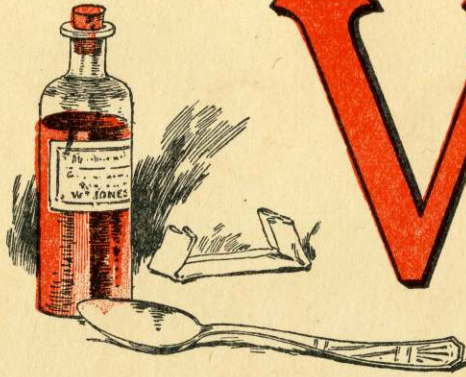
T

of the Baby's A.B.C.



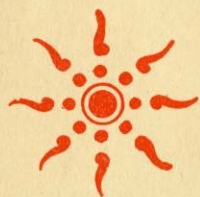

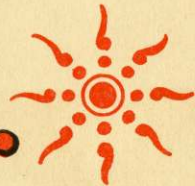
