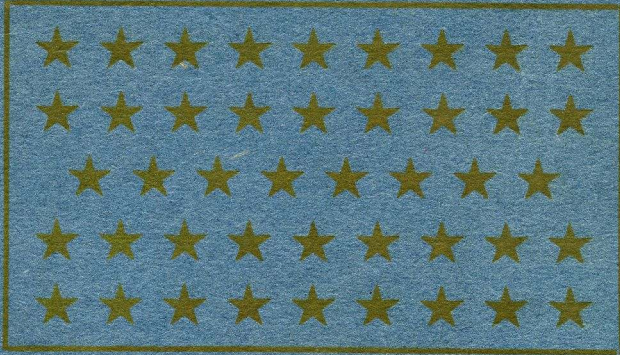

Monongalia County in the Great War

Monongalia County was 100 per cent American during every minute of the war.

This county not only went over the top with lots of room to spare in every drive, but her men and women served faithfully on every field to which they were sent. Her sons died on almost every bloody battlefield of France. More than a score of lives were lost from battle and disease in camp or in the trenches. But her sons who stayed back home did their share just as surely. The home service work in this county was especially notable. The various campaigns were carried on in a systematic way that brought about an unusual degree of success.

The Monongalia boys got into service early. Old Company "L" was among the ones to get started soon after the war started. Then the boys from the University, including a number of Monongalia Countians, enlisted with the Fifteenth Engineers at Pittsburgh and soon afterward crossed the seas. There was a veritable exodus of young students from this county who enlisted early and rushed to training camps. Scores of them received commissions. In every camp, this county was well represented. Enlistments in every branch of the service was heavy, and the demand was everywhere for the service that would insure "action." Bomb-proof jobs were never popular with boys from this county. The boys from France have returned singly or in groups, but an especially large number came back with the 80th Division.

Most of these introductory lines, however, must be given those who did not wear the khaki. The long columns of names that fill up the pages of this program is sufficient testimony of the part played by the Monongalia boys, along with the splendid honor roll. For after all, service is sufficient praise in itself and this long roll is an honor to the county of Monongalia.

But the hundreds of men and women who stayed at home, and did their share, must receive recognition. There must be special recognition of the members of Monongalia County Bar Association, who were active in various ways. These men formed the legal advisory board and the legal revision board. The Draft Board members, the members of the County Council for Defense, members of the committees on the United War Work, War Camp Recreation Fund, Red Cross and the Liberty and Victory Loan campaigns should have received their commissions, also. They were real soldiers, too.

Every campaign went over the top in this county. The quota in the four drives of the Liberty Loan and the one drive of the Victory Loan campaigns was almost doubled. All the other quotas were

over-subscribed. Every one in the county seemed willing to work and to pour out his money while the men in arms were pouring out their life's blood over there against the beastly Boche.

Space does not permit mentioning the names of all these men and women who did their bit and more. Hundreds of men gave weeks and months of their time but only one list can be published.

This list is the Red Cross honor list to which Red Cross ribbons and buttons were issued. The buttons are the same in each case but the ribbons tell the real story. The khaki ribbon denotes 400 hours, the blue ribbon 800 hours, the blue ribbon with one white stripe 1600 hours and the blue ribbon with two white stripes 2400 hours or over.

There were fifteen Morgantown women and one woman from the Battelle auxiliary who won the coveted ribbon with the two white stripes. All honor to such patriotic work. There are seven Morgantown men and nine Battelle district men listed in the Red Cross workers of more than 400 hours also.
