

NOTE.—This library had its beginning in 1880 by the donation of a few books to the High School by the present Superintendent. To these were added shortly afterwards several copies by other friends of the school, and from time to time within the last seven years particularly, additions have been made to the library until the present number of volumes has been collected.

The dictionaries, cyclopædias and part of the other books of reference were purchased by the Board of Education, but most of the funds have been raised through entertainments given by pupils and teachers. At one of these entertainments \$125.00 were realized. About one hundred volumes of a miscellaneous character were received from the old Town Library. Most of the books are of good size, in substantial binding, and cost, on an average, about one dollar per volume. Appleton's Cyclopædia of Biography, 6 volumes, the price of which was \$42.00, is the latest and best addition to the library.

Books of reference are within the reach of pupils in the school room at all times, while under the rules governing the library, works of a general character may be taken home and kept for a period not exceeding ten days. Many books are read by parents and others not directly connected with the school.
