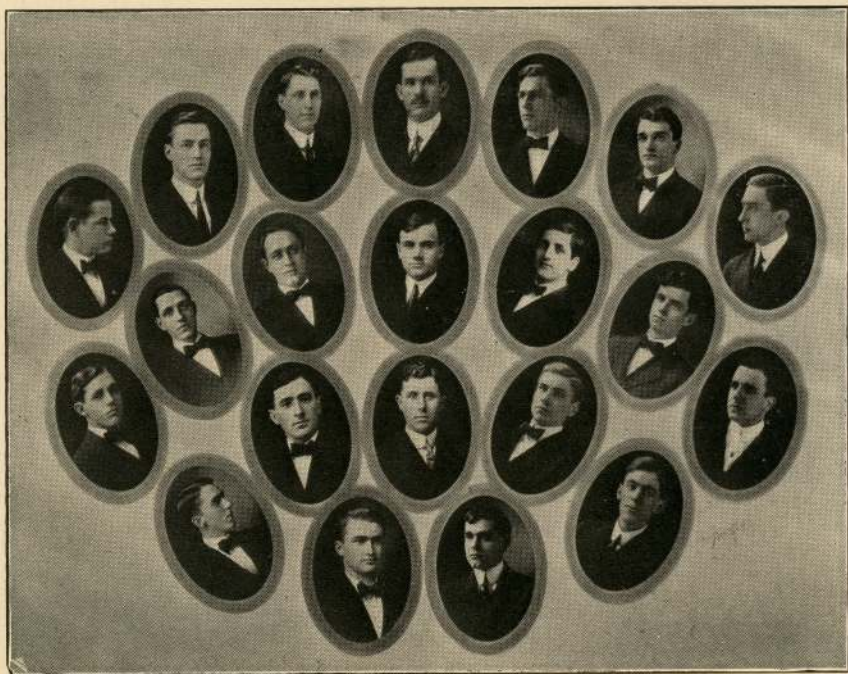

## GREETING:

Again West Virginia Alpha extends a most cordial greeting to her Alumni and to her sister chapters, informing them of her sure advancement during the past year.

At the beginning of the school year, twelve of last year's men were on hand. Those who failed to return were Brothers France, Bowers, Mitchell, Gillooly, Llewellyn, Stemple, Hodges, McGill and Baird. Brothers France and Bowers are in Johns Hopkins; Mitchell is with the Pittsburg Valve and Supply Company, Pittsburg; Gillooly, a lawyer, Weston, W. Va.; McGill is engaged in business, Dawson, Pa.; Baird is with the United States Steel Company, McKeesport, Pa.; Llewellyn is teaching at Uniontown, Pa.; Stemple is a teacher in the West Liberty Normal, and Hodges has a place in the Charleston High School.

As our Chapter house was being repaired during the early fall we were somewhat handicapped in our rushing, but secured six new men and on November 20th initiated:

After the initiation a most enjoyable banquet was held in our own dining room. Dr. Buchannon was toastmaster and quite a number of the Morgantown and Fairmont Alumni were present.

We were more than pleased to have Brother Merrill, New York Epsilon with us during the winter and spring quarter. Brother Merrill took his A. B. last year at Yale and is taking law here.

In all lines of college life our men have been active. In the class room our record is one of which we feel proud while in the social, literary and athletic line Phi Psi are "right at" the front. Brother Fred Koeltz is editor-in-chief of the Monticola, Brother McCullough is president, and Brother Caldwell is secretary, of the Junior Law Class. Brother Kennedy succeeded in capturing the Tax Commission prize last spring, while the same prize is sure to fall to Phi Psi this year as Brothers Evans and Reger are the only men out for it. On the Monticola board we have Brother Eckman, on the Athenaeum Brother Evans, and on the Monongalian Brother Kennedy. Brother Hamilton again landed the presidency of the Pan Hellenic Dancing Club. In the cadet band, the best one in years, Brother Spencer represents Phi Psi. Brother Evans is an assistant in the English depart-



ment and Cadet Adjutant in the Corps of Cadets. Brother Eckman was again appointed assistant in the chemistry department. On the Junior Prom. Committee we had Brother Fred Koeltz. Brother Fred takes the place of Brother Herman in the Mountain, the oldest honorary organization in the University which admits men only. In the English Club, the oldest, we have Brother Evans. Brother Evans has also been re-elected as a member of the Athenaeum board and will be next years' editor-in-chief.

On the 'Varsity baseball team Brother Merrill has been starring as catcher. Brother Morris is captain of this year's track team of which Brothers Gawthrop, Spencer and Scott, and Weaver (Pledge) are members. In the U. of P. meet Brother Spencer won his W. V. in the pole vault. Brother Stemple has been selected as assistant manager of next year's football team. Aside from these Phi Psis have been seen in the lead in most of the inter-class contests during the year.

Out of the six students selected to represent the College of Law in its Annual Mock trial to be given during Commencement two are Phi Psis, Brothers Kennedy and Hamilton.

In the interfraternity baseball league Phi Psi is in the race for the beautiful silver trophy offered by Senator Joe McDermott.

The most important and elaborate social entertainment ever attempted by this Chapter was given on Saturday, December 12, Mrs. Sarah B. Cochran, to whom the chapter owes so much, was the guest of honor. In the afternoon from two until 5 o'clock the entire house

was thrown open to the public. Everything was nicely decorated and especially the dining room, where lunch was served to the visitors. At seven o'clock a dinner in honor of Mrs. Cochran was served in the new dining room. Covers were laid for thirty. Those present were Mrs. Cochran, the Morgantown Alumni and their wives, a representative each from the Wheeling Phi Psi Club and the Fairmont Alumni Association and some men of the active chapter. After the dinner a reception was given to which were invited all of the out-of-town Alumni, the Morgantown Alumni and wives, and a few others intimately connected with Phi Psi. The three affairs of the day were well managed and without doubt a complete success.

On February 19 our annual military ball open house was held. The day was a delightful one and the whole house was filled from two until five with one of the jolliest crowds we have ever had.

The Fairmont Alumni Association entertained the active chapter at Brother Brooks Fleming's bungalow near Fairmont on January 9. Most of the men attended and returned with many praises for the Fairmont A. A.

Our usual thirtieth of May open house was held this year on the twenty-ninth. During the forenoon lemonade and ginger cakes were served on the front porch to most of the young people of the city.

Founders' day was observed in an informal manner. The active men and visitors gathered around the big fire place and listened to stories and anecdotes till a late hour. Brother Dr. Buchannon, Pa,

Alpha '75 and Charter members Meyers and Trotter helped make the program a complete success.

Sphinx, an honorary fraternity was installed in West Virginia University this year. Brother Hamilton was a charter member. For its Link Day ceremony on May 7 all classes were dismissed. All the students and many visitors gathered on the campus to witness the ceremony. Two of our Brothers, Merrill and Eckman were chosen.

West Virginia Alpha was represented at the D. C. held at Baltimore by Brothers Kennedy, Reger and McCullough.

Brother Trotter, one of our charter members became a member of the Law Faculty at the beginning of the year.

Brother J. C. McWhorter has been selected to deliver the annual Alumni address on June 14, at which Brother Reger will respond to the toast "The Senior Class."

"'Tis a consummation devoutly to be wished." So said the members of West Virginia Alpha ten years or more ago when discussing the feasibility of building a new chapter house. But scheme and strive as they would the goal seemed no nearer until at the Founders day

celebration in 1902 Brother Buchanan brought us the unexpected but none the less welcome news that through the generosity of Mrs. Sarah B. Cochran, of Dawson, Pa., the dream had become a reality. In the spring '02 the chapter moved to a comfortable house on Spruce Street, an ideal location, and was at home in "The James Cochran House of Phi Kappa Psi." Time grew apace, and our rivals one after another began to acquire chapter houses, each seeking to outdo us. Mrs. Cochran, however, did not cease her generosity with a single gift, but caused the house to be thoroughly remodeled in 1903, giving us a chapter home of which we were proud.

Changing conditions at West Virginia within the last few years made it seem advisable to us to add a dining room to our home and once more the problem of building confronted us. Again Mrs. Cochran came to our aid, announcing last year her intention of adding the much desired dining room, together with servants quarters and additional living rooms. Brother Dickey, of West Virginia Alpha, was chosen as the architect and was practically given carte blanche. Work on the new building, for it really is a new building, began at the close of the school year in June, and on Saturday, December 12, 1908, we had the pleasure of showing our friends our new home.

The house now contains twelve bed rooms, parlor, library, reception hall, dining room, kitchen, servants quarters and a large meeting hall. Our dining room is one of the finest in the city. It is finished in old English style and in it are two massive tables, buffet

and chairs in the same finish. The walls above the wainscoting are decorated with a beautiful hunting scene.

One room on the second floor has been fitted up and set apart for the use of Mrs. Cochran while she is in the city. It is the desire of the chapter that she frequently occupy this room as the guest of the chapter.

We have not yet secured the photographs of all the Alumni for the chapter hall. We now have quite a number of Phi Psi photos, but we hope to make the collection complete. If you have not yet done so please send yours to us with 50 cents for framing.

We enclose rushing blanks which we hope you will fill out and send us. Please remember that we have nine strong competitors here and that every little helps in getting new men.

In closing we will say just this, come back and see us.
